In reading we will be using Fountas and Pinnell with Mrs. Halsey

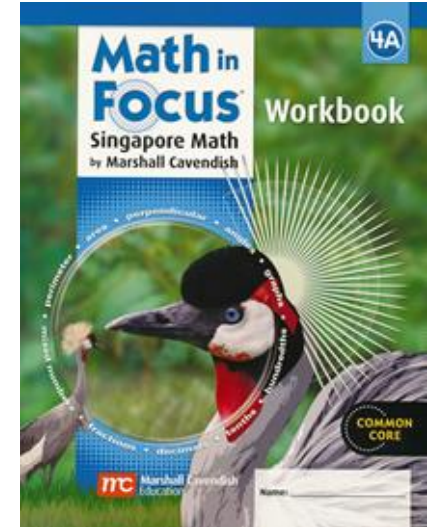


In Social Studies we will be using Ohio Studies Weekly with Mrs. Breedlove!

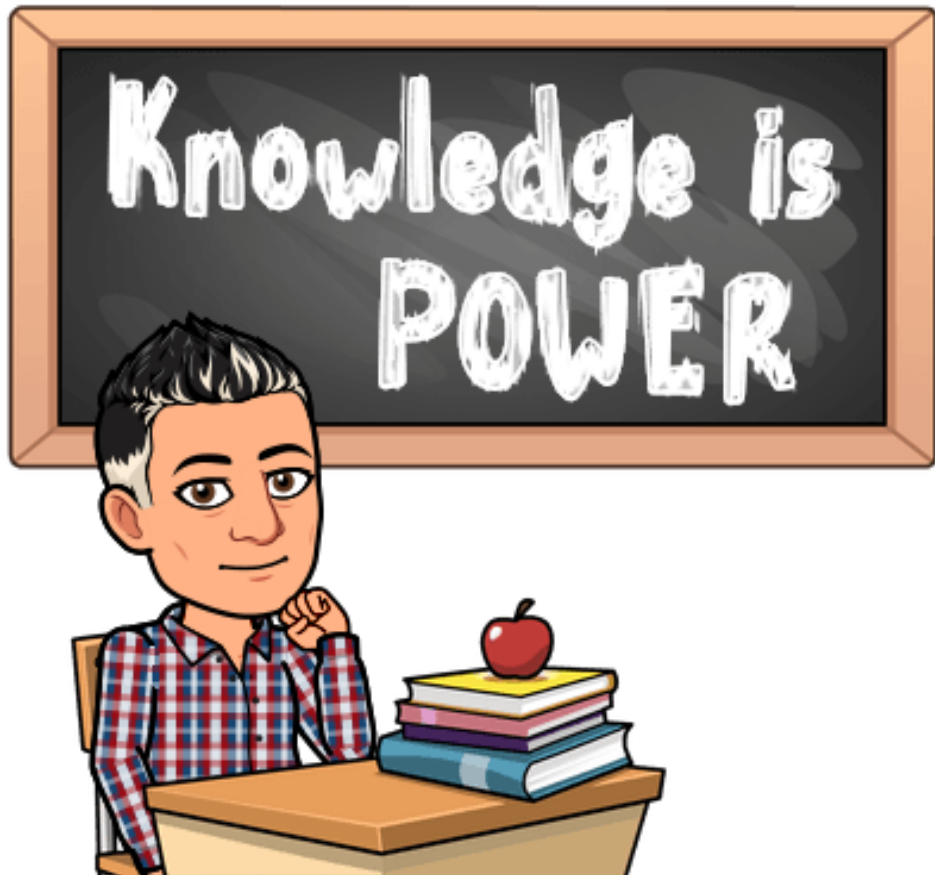
- We follow the same schedule each day...

- You are always allowed to use your notebooks as a guide when doing math classwork.

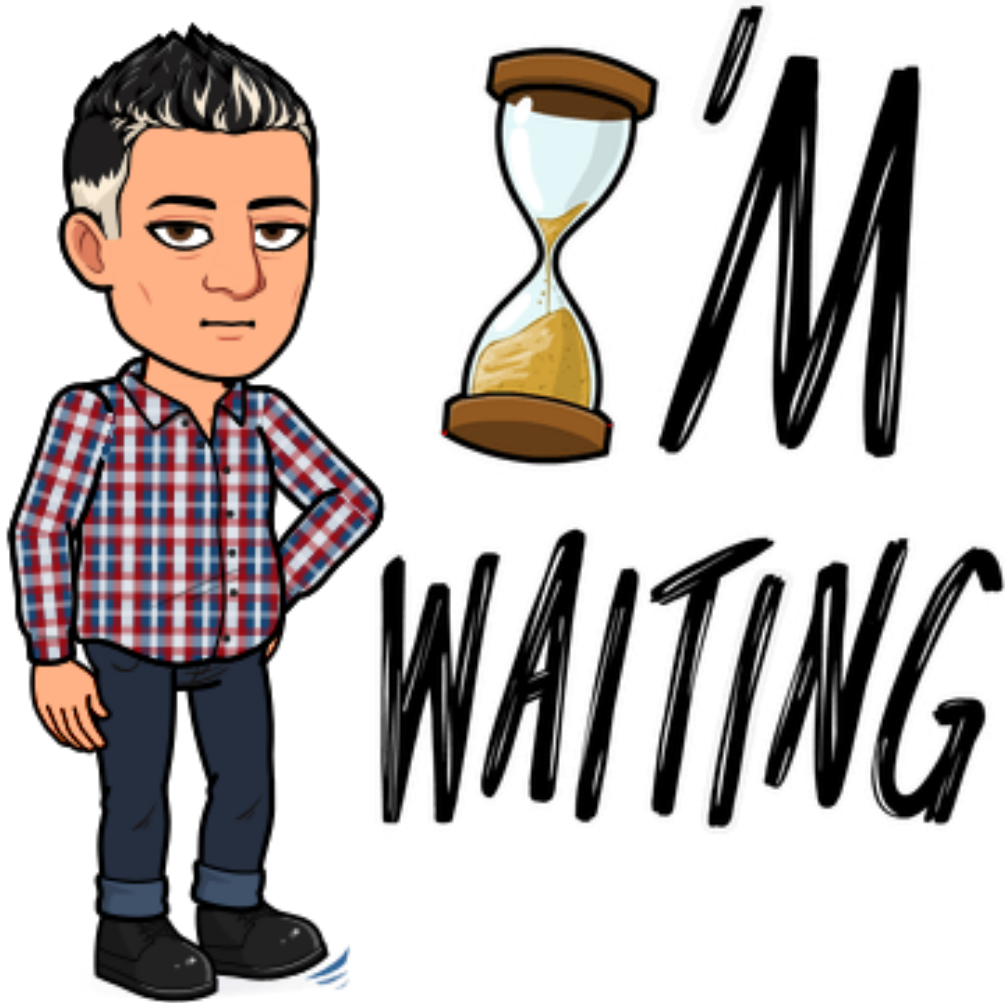


Homework

Communication

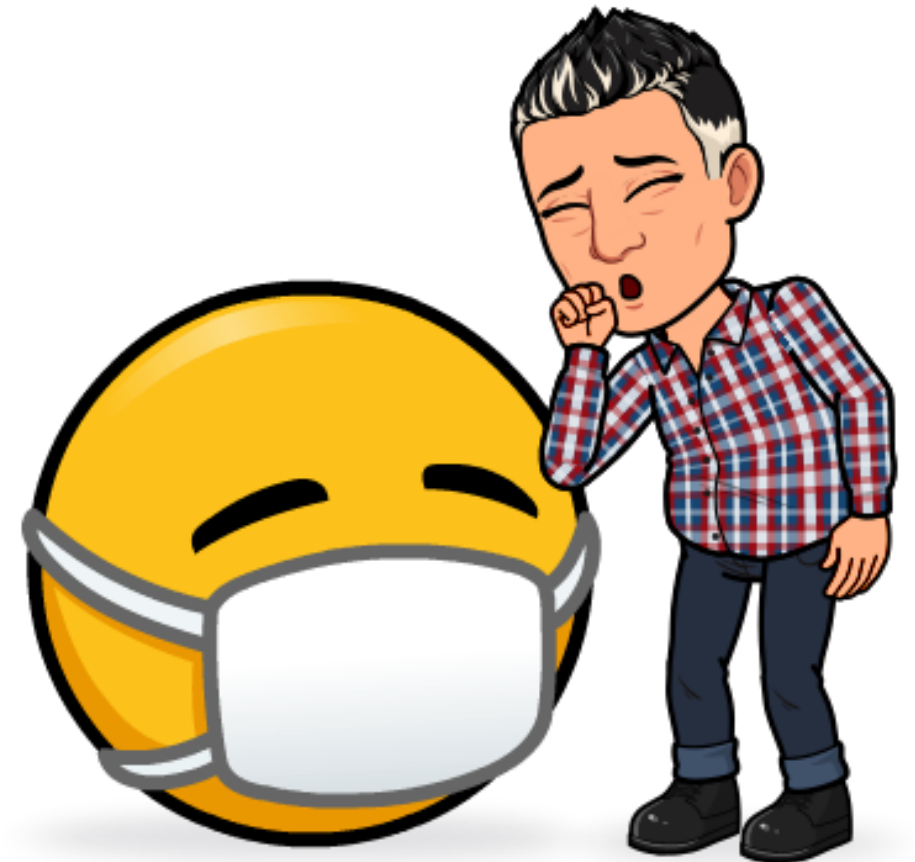
- Remind is used by the school and district. Occasionally, we will also send messages.
